

St Joseph's Primary School offers five organised out of school sports:

- Miniball/Basketball
- Flippaball
- Netball
- Hockey
- Touch Rugby

Basketball / Miniball

Miniball/Basketball is open to our Year 2–6 students. Teams are registered by semester (two terms). All teams are registered in the North Harbour Basketball league. www.harbour.basketball

- Games are played at the North Shore Events Centre/AUT Campus.
- Year 2–6 teams play on Tuesday afternoon/evening.
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team.
- It is compulsory for all players to have a mouth guard.
- Year 5/6 players are provided with a Basketball Singlet.
- Year 3/4 players require a St Joseph's School sports uniform.
- Year 2 players can wear a red t-shirt and navy sports shorts.

Flippaball

Flippaball is a modified version of water polo and children must be able to swim confidently and tread water unsupported for at least three minutes to participate in this sport. St Joseph's Primary School offers Newbies League to years 2–3 and Flippa Ball League to years 4–6. Teams are entered into the North Harbour Water Polo Primary competition and are registered each term. www.northharbourwaterpolo.co.nz

- Games are played at the Millennium Centre, Mairangi Bay.
- All teams play on a Sunday afternoon/evening.
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team.

Netball

Netball is open to students of all year levels. Year 0–5 teams are entered into the Kidzplay Netball competition. Year 6 teams are entered into the Netball North Harbour competition. www.kidzplaynetball.co.nz

- Kidzplay Netball games are played at Pinehurst School and Netball North Harbour games are played at Onewa Courts, Northcote.
- Year 0–5 teams play on a Saturday morning/early afternoon.
- Year 6 teams play on a Wednesday afternoon/evening.
- Parents are required to coach/manage or umpire the team.
- Netball dresses are provided for the season to year 4–6 teams and if numbers allow will be offered to year 3. Year 0–2 should wear a red t-shirt and a navy short or lycra skort or their school sports uniform.

Hockey

Hockey is open to students from years 3 to 6. All hockey teams are entered into the North Harbour Hockey competition. www.harbourhockey.org.nz

- Games are played at North Harbour Hockey Stadium, Paul Mathews Dr.
- All teams play on a Monday afternoon/evening.
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team.
- All players require a St Joseph's School sports uniform, navy socks, shin pads, mouth guard and a hockey stick.

Touch Rugby

Touch Rugby is open to students of all year levels. All teams are entered into the Local Touch Module competition. www.localtouch.co.nz

- All teams are entered in to the Thursday afternoon module usually held at Becroft Park Forrest Hill. Venue TBC by council annually.
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team.
- Year 3–6 players require a St Joseph's School sports uniform.
- Year 0–2 players can wear a red t-shirt and navy sports shorts.
