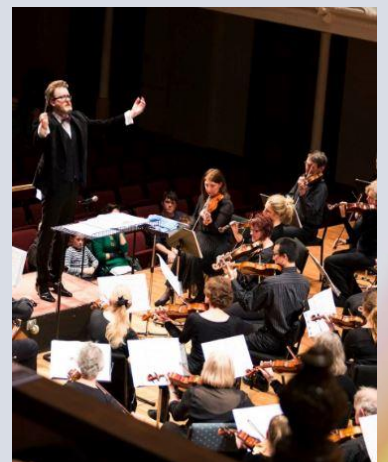


The St. Joseph's School Christmas Concert
