

St Joseph's Primary School offers five organised out of school sports:

- Basketball
- Splash Polo
- Netball
- Hockey
- Summer Touch Rugby

Basketball

Basketball is open to our Year 1-6 students. Teams are registered by semester (two terms). Teams are registered either in the North Harbour Basketball league www.harbour.basketball or the Breakers competition www.juniorbreakers.basketball/leagues

- Games are played at the North Shore Events Centre/AUT Campus or at the BNZ Breakers - 7 Atlas Place Mairangi Bay
- Year 1-6 teams play in the afternoons/evenings
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team
- All students are provided with a sports top from the school
- Players will require navy sports shorts

Splash Polo

Splash Polo is a modified version of water polo and children must be able to swim confidently and tread water unsupported for at least three minutes to participate in this sport. St Joseph's Primary School offers Newbies League to years 2-3 and Splash Polo League to years 4-6. Teams are entered into the North Harbour Water Polo Primary competition and are registered each term www.northharbourwaterpolo.co.nz

- Games are played at the Millennium Centre, Mairangi Bay
- All teams play on a Sunday afternoon/evening
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team

Netball

Netball is open to students of all year levels. All teams are registered to play in the Netball North Harbour competition www.netballnorthharbour.co.nz

- Netball North Harbour games are played at Onewa Courts, Northcote
- Year 1-4 teams play on a Monday afternoon
- Year 5-6 teams play on a Wednesday afternoon/evening
- Parents are required to coach/manage or umpire the team
- All teams will be provided with a sports uniform from the school

Hockey

Hockey is open to students from years 3 to 6. All hockey teams are entered into the North Harbour Hockey competition www.harbourhockey.org.nz

- Games are played at North Harbour Hockey Stadium, Paul Mathews Dr
- All teams play on a Monday afternoon/evening
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team
- All players will be provided with a sports top from the school
- All players will require navy sports shorts, navy socks, shin pads, mouth guard and a hockey stick

Summer Touch Rugby

Touch Rugby is open to students of all year levels. All teams are entered into the Term 4 Local Touch Module competition www.localtouch.co.nz

- All teams are entered into the Thursday afternoon module usually held at Sunnynook Park
- Parents are required to coach/manage the team
- All players will be provided with a sports top from the school
- All players will require navy sports shorts
